## Entry Form for Poultry & Rabbits

When you enter your animal in the Madison County Fair, you agree to the following terms.

- 1) The animal **MUST** stay at the fair the entire time to receive any awards (ribbons and possible premium money) that the animal wins.
- 2) The animal's **OWNER** is responsible for feeding and watering their own animals. This **MUST** be done twice a day. Mornings before 9:00 a.m. AND Evenings.
- 3) Cages **MUST** be cleaned out once a day before 9:00 a.m. This is the owners responsibility. **Note: If cages and animals are not taken care of, we can deny future entry of animals into the Fair.**
- 4) Owners **MUST** sign up for and show up for **a minimum of ONE shift (per species)** during the week to watch over the cages for safety reasons. If you miss your time, you lose any ribbons, money or awards that the animal may win.
- 5) On Saturday when you pick up your animals **you are in charge of cleaning out the cage** that your animal was in before you leave. Check with the area person in charge to have your cage inspected so you can receive any winnings and to sign out your animal. **Saturday pick up times are from 2 P.M. to 4 P.M.**
- 6) **If owner is a child under 12, they must have a Parent or Guardian sign animals in and out.**
- 7) Only feed and show items can stay under the tables during the fair. **All transporting cages/boxes must go home.**

**NOTICE / WARNING:** In the past there have been breakouts of **Avian Bird Flu** in Poultry and **Hemorrhagic Fever** in Rabbits. These diseases are highly contagious and 90% to 100% Fatal. There is no cure for either one of these diseases. **The Madison County Fair board is not responsible for the health of any animal entered into the Fair. Entry of animals is at the owner's own risk.**
